## Brief About GhaFFaP

- » GhaFFaP is a Federation of Forest and Farm Producer Organisations( FFPOs)
- Members drawn from three (3) Ecological Zones (ie
  Savannah, Transition and Forest Zones of Ghana)
- » GhaFFaP's evolution influenced by the Forest and Farm Facility (FFF) & members desire to maximize Strength in Numbers to:
- Build Sustainable and Profitable Forest and Farm Businesses
- Contribute to Shaping National Policy
- Promote Climate Resilient Landscapes at scale

Membership-**1,042,780** made of **478,623** women (46%), and **564,157** men (54%)) of which 20%) are youth representing **12** FFPOs



## GhaFFaP Journey - Key Achievements to date


## **GhaFFaP Internal Capacity :**


- Fully consituted and functional internal structures National & Zonal Leadership (SC, BIT, WCW etc)
  - The GhaFFaP Women's Champions Wing (WCW) constituted to give effect to GhaFFaP prioritising women
  - Completed all **official registration requirements** ( including the registration of the GhaFFaP cooperative /business wing)
  - Finalised **GhaFFaP Constitution** & related operational guidelines
  - 1<sup>st</sup> **GhaFFaP General Assembly** / Annual General Meeting held in September 2020
  - The GhaFFaP Agenda 2030 Strategy completed and published (yet to be launched) : a comprehensive 10 year strategy for GhaFFaP set against 5 strategic pillars & aligned to up to 15 SDGs
  - Developed two (2) Business Cases for the Savanna & Forest /Transition Zones for a basket of products

## **External Relations & Partnerships :**

- Successfully organised the 1<sup>ST</sup> in the Series of the GhaFFaP National Dialogues with support from FAO
- GhaFFaP led the production of a short video documentary to hilight the plight of farmers due to the Floods in Northern Ghana bringing to sharp national attention
- Completed a study on the impact of COVID-19 on GhaFFaP members Productivity & Businesses ( yet to be launched)
- In collaboration with the Forestry Commission (FC) recently concluded zonal policy dialogues ( in Feb. & March 2021)
- Strengthened GhaFFaP strategic partnerships : eg FAO, UN RC Office, GIZ, MoFA, FC, Energy Commission, Financial & Business service providers, etc
